

PRIVACY POLICY

depression2extinction (“d2e”) places a high priority on protecting your privacy. This privacy policy was created in order to demonstrate d2e’s firm commitment to the privacy of our clients and website users. This policy explains what types of information is collected by d2e’s website, www.depression2extinction.org, and how this information is used.

What personally identifiable information is collected?

Like most website operators, d2e collects non-personally-identifying information of the sort that web browsers and servers typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring site, and the date and time of each visitor request. d2e’s purpose in collecting non-personally identifying information is to better understand how d2e’s visitors use its website. From time to time, d2e may release non-personally-identifying information in the aggregate, e.g., by publishing a report on trends in the usage of its website.

d2e also collects potentially personally-identifying information like Internet Protocol (IP) addresses for logged in users and for users leaving comments. d2e only discloses logged in user and commenter IP addresses under the same circumstances that it uses and discloses personally-identifying information as described below, except that blog commenter IP addresses are visible and disclosed to the administrators of the blog where the comment was left.

Gathering of Personally-Identifying data

Certain visitors to d2e’s website choose to interact with d2e in ways that require d2e to gather personally-identifying information. The amount and type of information that d2e gathers depends on the nature of the interaction. Those who engage in transactions with d2e are asked to provide additional information, including as necessary the personal and financial information required to process those transactions. In each case, d2e collects such information only insofar as is necessary or appropriate to fulfill the purpose of the visitor’s interaction with d2e. d2e does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below. And visitors can always refuse to supply personally-identifying information, with the caveat that it may prevent them from engaging in certain website-related activities.

Email privacy

d2e does not provide, sell, or rent email addresses to anyone outside the organization. d2e will share users email address with our partners and affiliates, only if given consent by each individual user.

Aggregated Statistics

d2e may collect statistics about the behavior of visitors to its website. For instance, d2e may monitor the most popular posts on www.depression2extinction.org and may display this

information publicly or provide it to others. However, d2e does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below.

How your information may be used

We use your personal information to provide you with personalized service; to send email alerts to you; to answer your requests; etc. You may choose to opt out at any time, which will cease all communications from us. We may also use your information to track visitors of our website. This lets us see which of our features are the most popular so we can better serve our users' needs. It also lets us provide aggregate data about our traffic (not identifying you personally, but showing how many visitors used which features, for example) to outside parties

Protection of Certain Personally-Identifying Information

d2e discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only to those of its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations that (i) need to know that information in order to process it on d2e's behalf or to provide services available at d2e's website, and (ii) that have agreed not to disclose it to others. d2e will not rent or sell potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information to anyone. Other than to its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations, as described above, d2e discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only in response to a subpoena, court order or other governmental request, or when d2e believes in good faith that disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect the property or rights of d2e, third parties or the public at large. d2e takes all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information.

Cookies

A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's computer, and that the visitor's browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. d2e uses cookies to help d2e identify and track visitors, their usage of d2e website, and their website access preferences. d2e visitors who do not wish to have cookies placed on their computers should set their browsers to refuse cookies before using d2e's website, with the drawback that certain features of d2e's website may not function properly without the aid of cookies.

Business Transfers

If d2e, or substantially all of its assets were acquired, or in the unlikely event that d2e goes out of business or enters bankruptcy, user information would be one of the assets that is transferred or acquired by a third party. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur, and that any acquirer of d2e may continue to use your personal information as set forth in this policy.

Ads

Ads appearing on any of our website may be delivered to users by advertising partners, who may set cookies. These cookies allow the ad server to recognize your computer each time they send you an online advertisement to compile information about you or others who use your

computer. This information allows ad networks to, among other things, deliver targeted advertisements that they believe will be of most interest to you. This Privacy Policy covers the use of cookies by d2e and does not cover the use of cookies by any advertisers. This website
